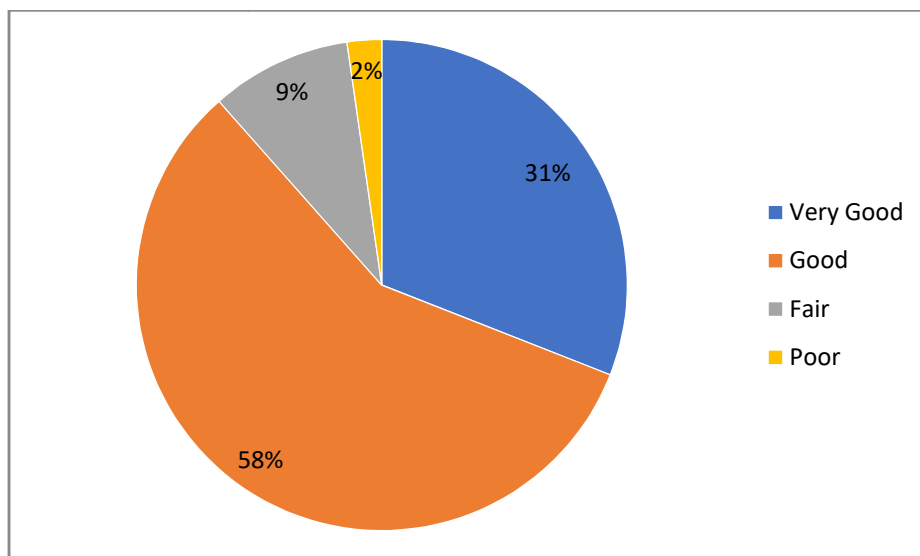

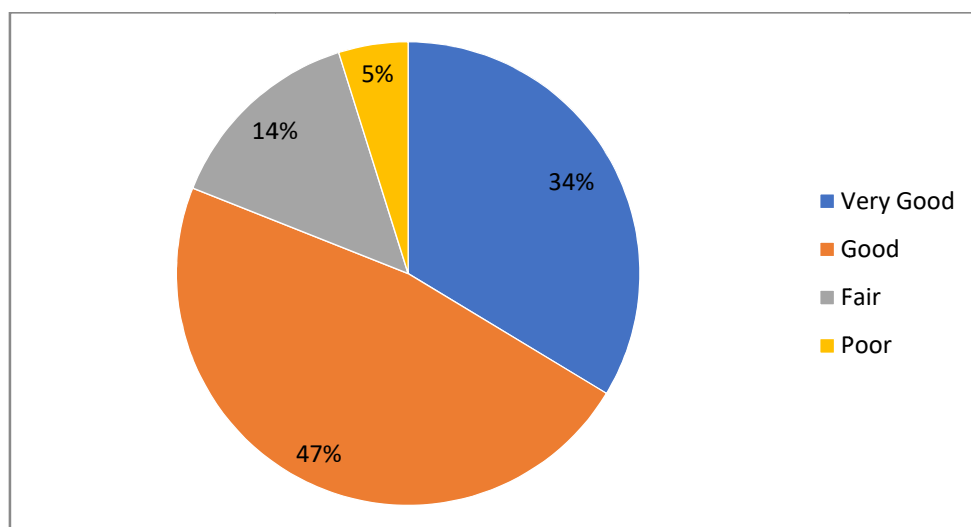
## STUDENTS FEEDBACK REPORT

The IQAC feedback Committee collected feedback from all the stakeholders of the institution using Google forms during the academic year 2022-23. Well-structured Google forms, prepared with the aim to collect realistic responses were circulated among students of the college. The feedbacks obtained were analyzed by using a 4 point rating scale. The detailed analysis of data obtained along with graphical representation is included below:

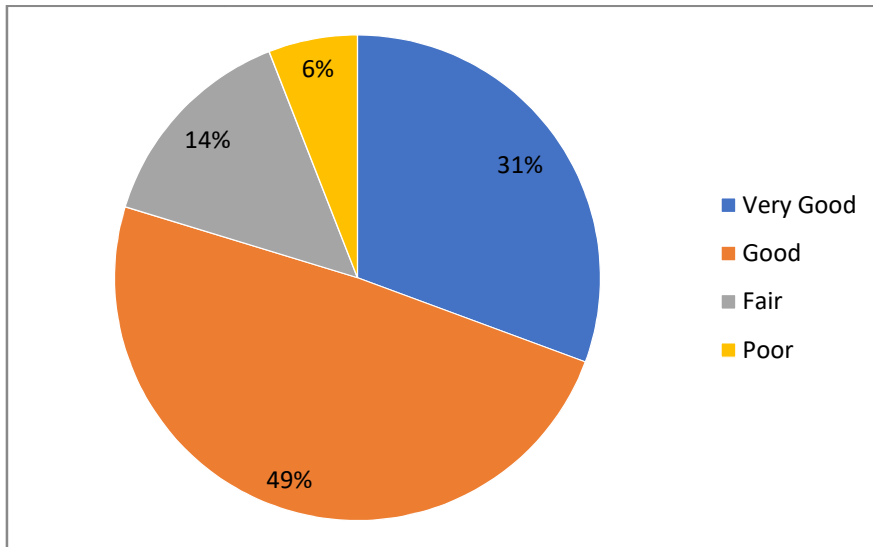

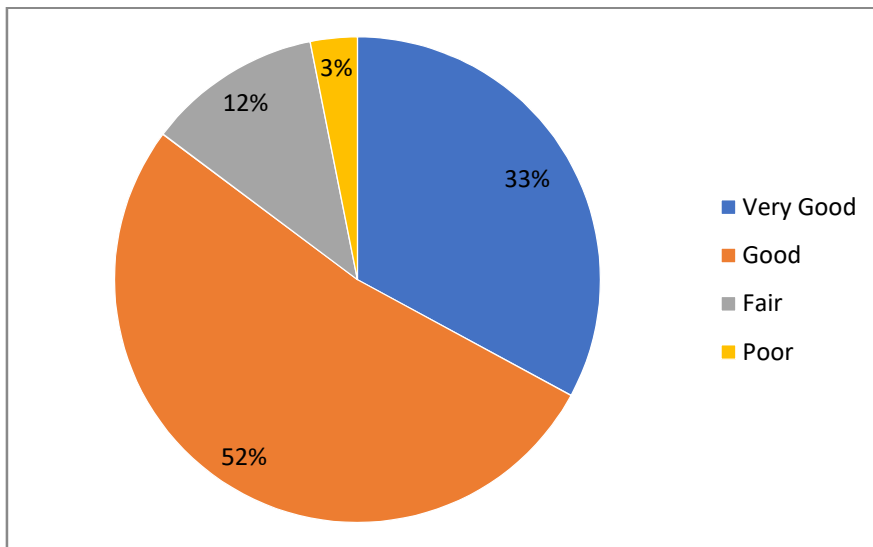

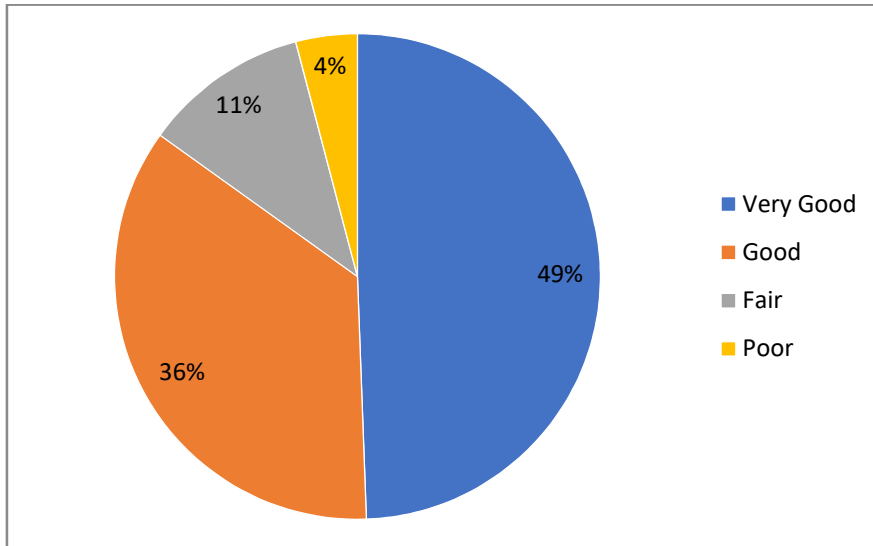


4) Capacity of curriculum in supporting higher studies

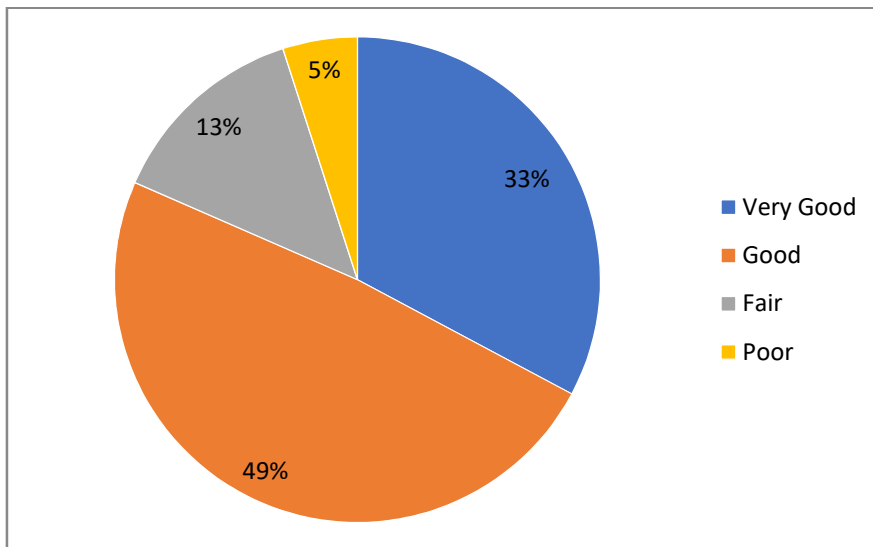

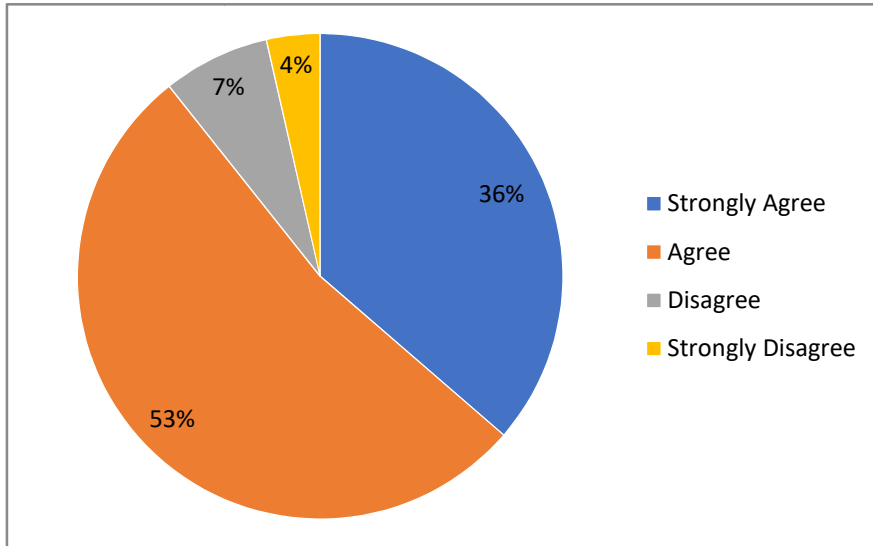

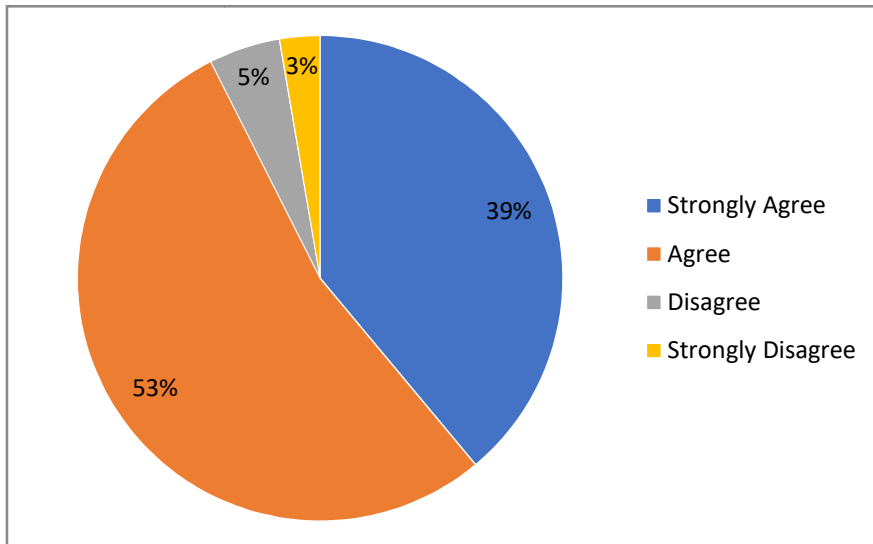




7) The teacher encourages the students to participate in extra-curricular, co-curricular activities and research projects

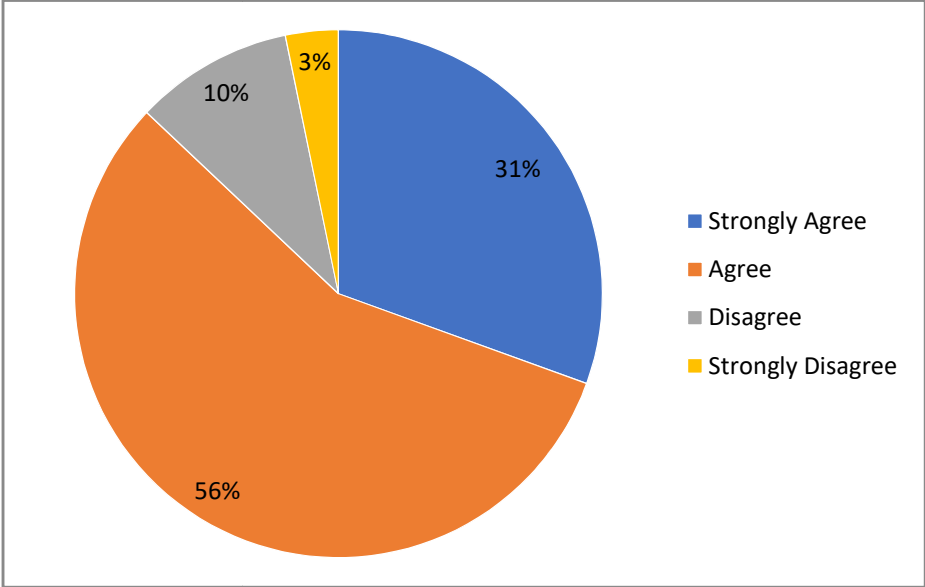


8) The teacher's attitude towards the students is friendly & helpful

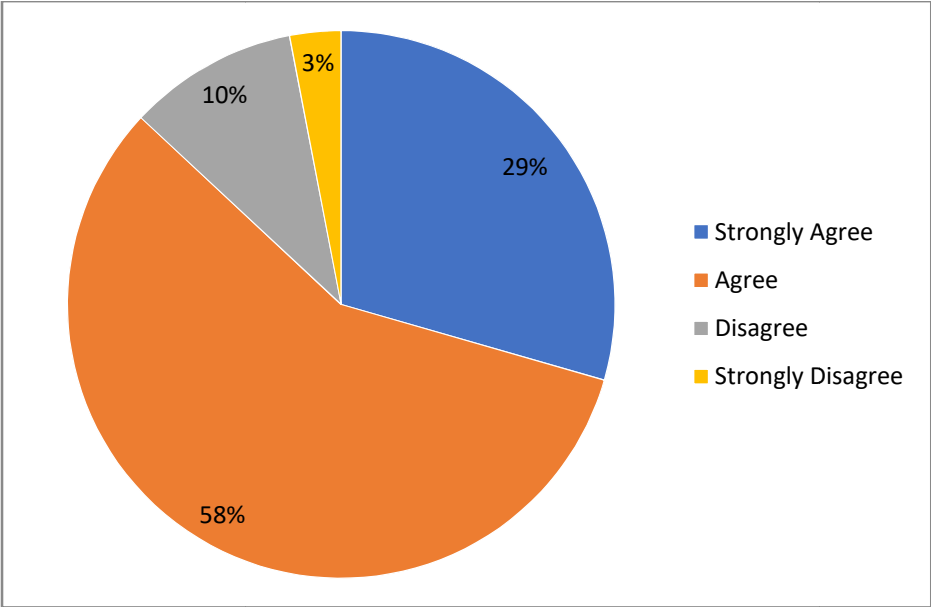




9) Help students in facing physical, emotional and learning challenges

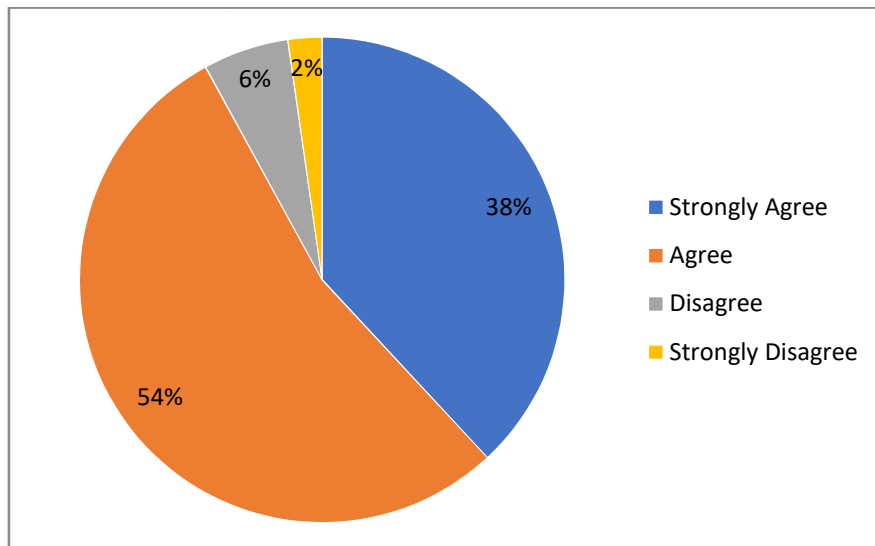


10) Helps students in realizing their strengths

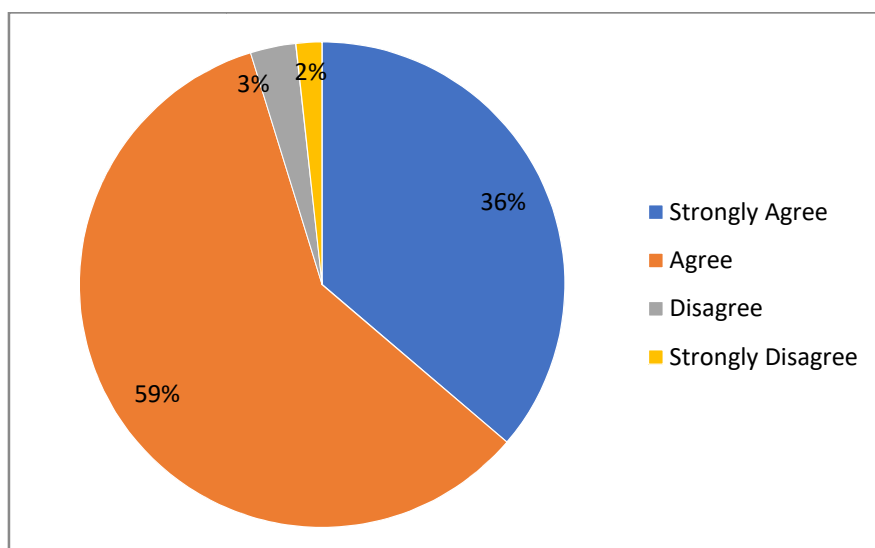




11) The institution offers opportunities and facilities to students irrespective of Gender

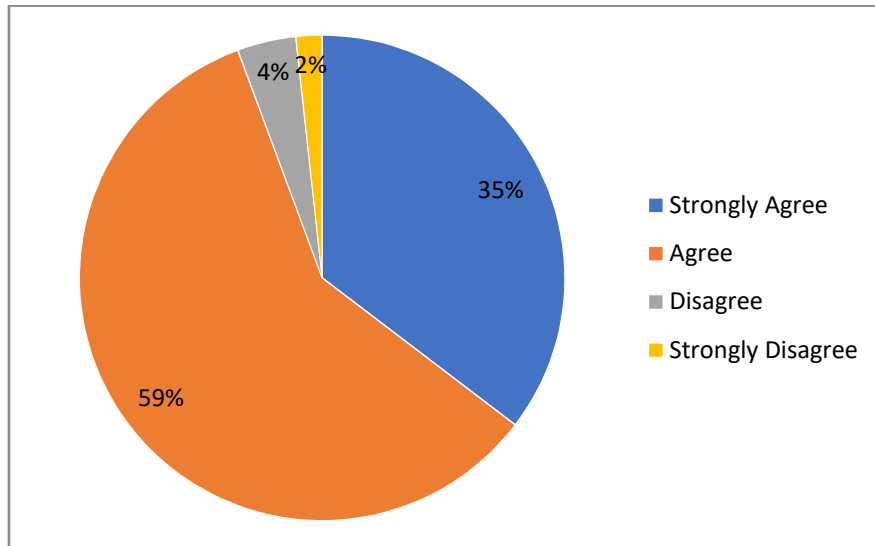


12) Proper instructions and demonstrations are given by the teacher prior to the conduct of the practical/experiment

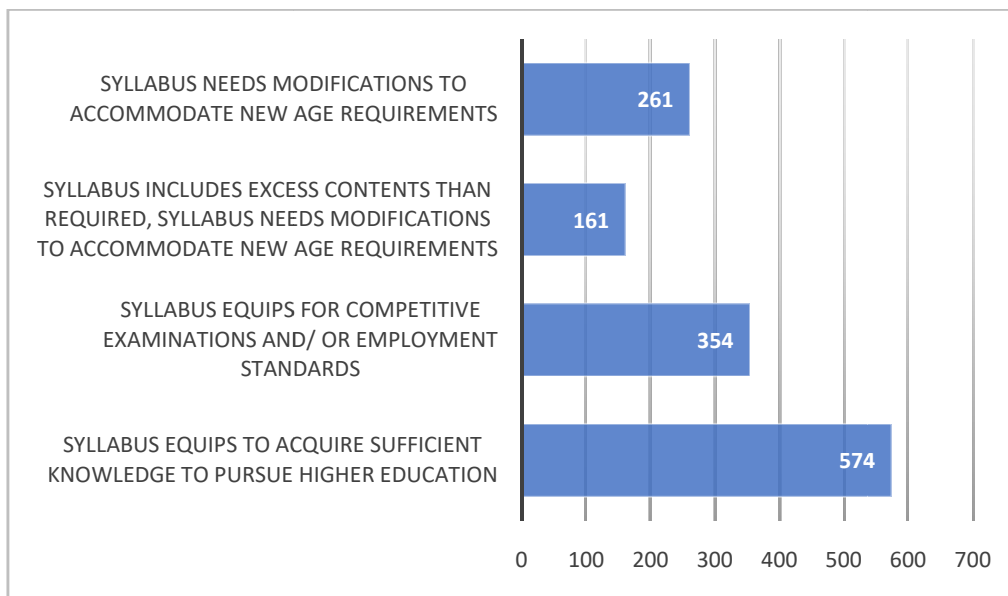




13) The teacher helps the students in smooth conduct of lab experiments

A survey of PG and UG students' response on the completion of the syllabus revealed that 32.2% of the students strongly agree that the teachers completed the entire syllabus, while 56% agreed, thus the majority had a positive response. The data regarding the students' comment on the internal evaluation process adopted by the institution elicited a positive response were 46 % of the students' responded very good and 51 % as good. Students had commented on the infrastructure facilities of the institution as very good by 33.3% and good by 51.3%. Regarding the library facilities 52.3% suggested that they were greatly satisfied and 35.2% claimed good.

The survey related to facilities for online learning revealed that 35% highly appreciated while 51% partly appreciated. 36.3% strongly agree and 53.7% agree in the survey of teacher encouragement of the students to participate in extra-curricular, co-curricular activities and research projects. The opinion about the attitude of teachers towards various academic interests of the students that 59.4 % of them agreed and 32.4 % strongly agreed. Majority of the students (Agree-53.9% and strongly agree 32.1%) claimed that the teachers and institute help the students in facing the physical, emotional and learning challenges. The 86.8 % of students (Agree-58.5% and strongly agree- 28.3 %) argued that this institution helps to realize their strengths. The 94.9 % of students (Agree -56%, Strongly agree 38.9 %) agreed that the teachers attitude towards the students is friendly and helpful. 95 % of students (Agree -55.9%, Strongly agree- 39.1%) argued that the proper instruction and demonstration are given by the teachers prior to the conduct of the practical experiments and 95.4 % of students agreed that lab experiments were conducted in a smooth manner. The 94.5 % of students agreed that this institution offers opportunities and facilities to the students irrespective of the gender. The 87.3 % of students agreed that the present curriculum is very helpful in supporting higher studies. 11.92 % students demanded the up gradation of the present syllabus including contents which accommodate new age requirements.
