Feedback Action Taken Report 2021-22



ACTION TAKEN REPORT-STUDENT FEEDBACK

IQAC of the college keenly analysed and explored the feedback from students using Google forms. IQAC determined to bring the matter before the college council along with the findings and recommendations pertaining to the infrastructure facilities and curriculum delivery processes. IQAC noted that a minority of the students were not satisfied with the teacher encouragement in the participation in extra-curricular, co-curricular activities and research projects. IQAC seriously addressed the issue and advised several steps to the HODs and teachers to tackle the issue. IQAC discussed the issue regarding discontent among the parents in the communication from the college or department regarding regular performance of the students, and IQAC directed the departments to organise regular PTA meetings to solve this issue.

The feedback collected from the students signifies that the students are satisfied with the system prevalent in the college.

Points to Ponder	Action Taken
1. Syllabus completion: 10% of the students expressed their dissatisfaction regarding the syllabus completion mission accomplished by the teachers.	IQAC of the college seriously probed into the issue and advised the HODs and teachers to prepare a syllabus completion report and made suggestions regarding time management.
2. The teacher encourages the students to participate in extra-curricular, co-curricular activities and research projects: 92% of the students had a positive response.	IQAC keenly analysed this matter and urged the faculty to organise diverse extra-curricular as well as co-curricular for nourishing the students' abilities and talents.
3. Help students in facing physical, emotional and learning challenges: 9% of the students had a negative response regarding the teachers helping mentality to aid students in facing physical, emotional turmoil.	IQAC deeply examined the problem and motivated the teachers to give necessary counselling sessions to the students having difficulties in emotional as well as mental wellbeing.
4. Helping attitude towards various academic interests of the students: 6% of the students were not satisfied in the helping attitude towards various academic interests of students	The issue was seriously analysed by IQAC and advised the departments to organise diverse academic activities in the department level to enhance the academic interests of the students.
5. Help students in realizing their strengths: 10 % of the students openly exposed that the teachers inability in recognising the strengths of students.	IQAC seriously examined the challenge and urged the teachers to communicate with the students, and understand their strengths and abilities.



6. Teacher's attitude friendly and helpful: 95% of the students expressed their satisfaction regarding teacher's attitude.	IQAC probed into the issue carefully and advised teachers to adopt various strategies that enhance their friendly attitude towards the students.
7. Proper instruction and demonstration for practical or experiments: 5% of the students were of the opinion that there was no proper instruction and demonstration for practical.	IQAC recommended the departments to implement certain creative strategies to have proper instruction and demonstration for practical and experiments.
8. The institution offers opportunities and facilities to students irrespective of Gender: 6% of the students were of the opinion that the institution was incapable to meet the requirements of the students, especially in providing opportunities to students irrespective of gender.	IQAC studied the issue emerged and advised the departments to organise seminars and awareness programmes on gender neutrality and motivated them to provide opportunities to all irrespective of gender.
